This mobile unit came from a plan to keep business going through a shop remodel in 2008.

Nick's Hamburger Shop prides itself as being that familiar stop, because of the effort made to keep the old ambiance. Not much has changed. Hamburgers are still served on a square of waxed paper to save on dish washing, and there's a glass of water for you if you ask for it. Along with a regular hamburger, Nicks offers a double hamburger, cheeseburger, and double cheeseburger with the option to add a variety of toppings.
